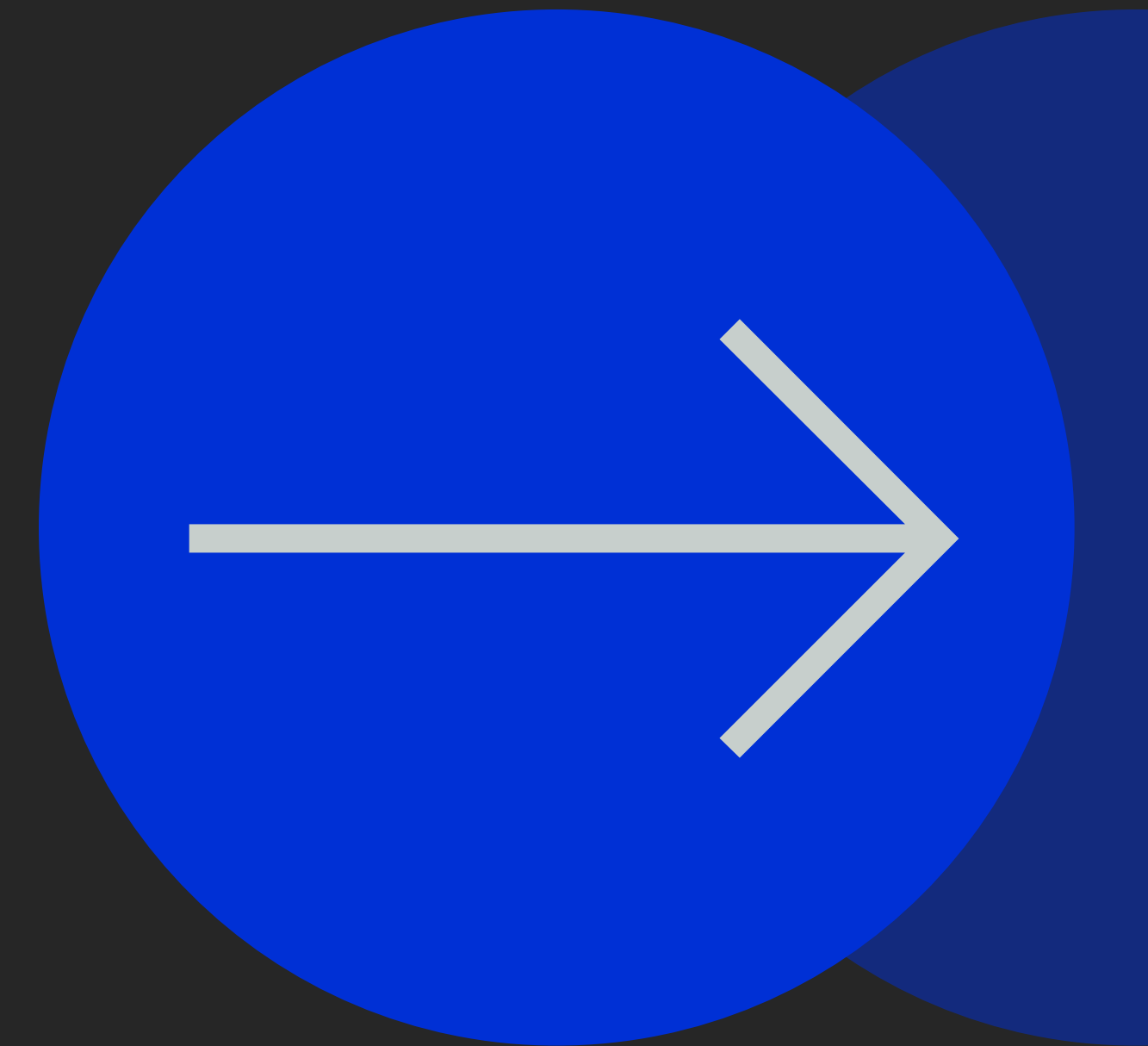

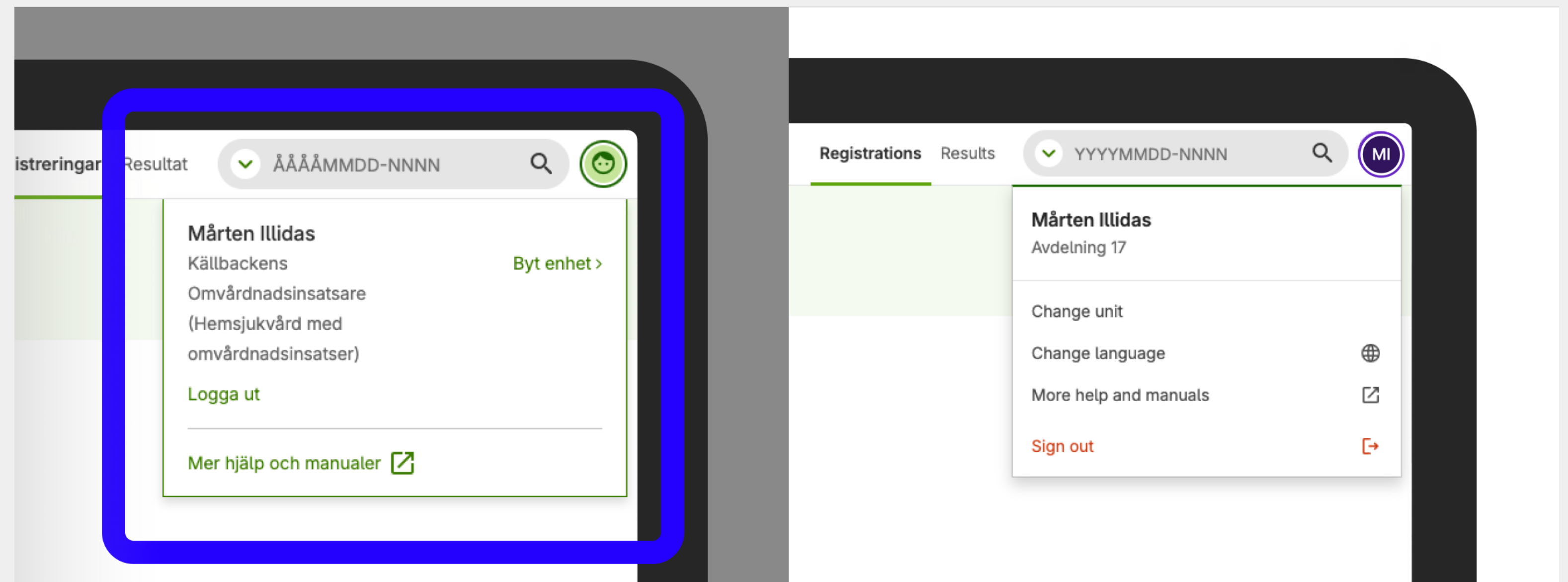
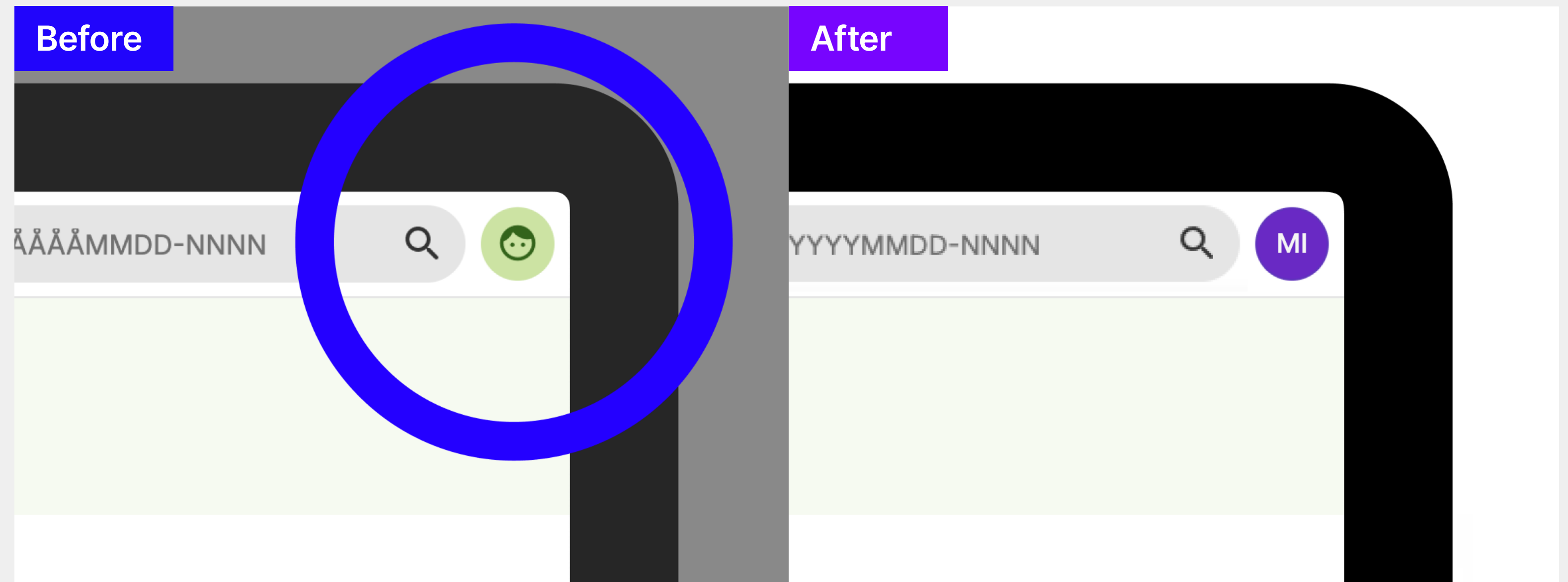

# User menu

Previously this was just an icon with a small face. Now in the latest version, it's instead the initials of the user that is signed in.

**Change unit** and **Change language** now goes to a separate settings page.

# Settings page

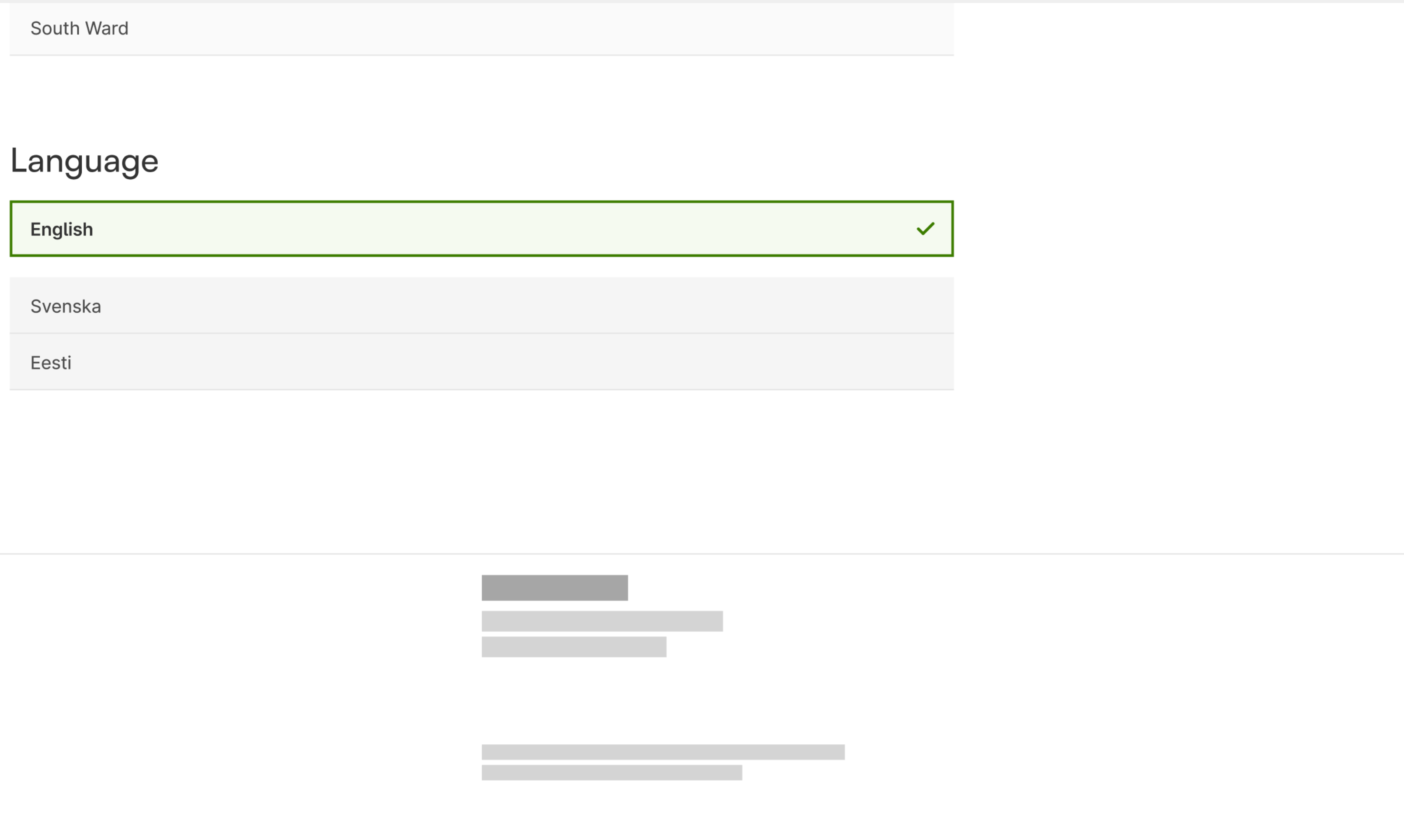
A separate settings page that holds everything that relates to the user that is signed in. Here you can **change unit** or **change language** (for registries with several languages).

# Settings page

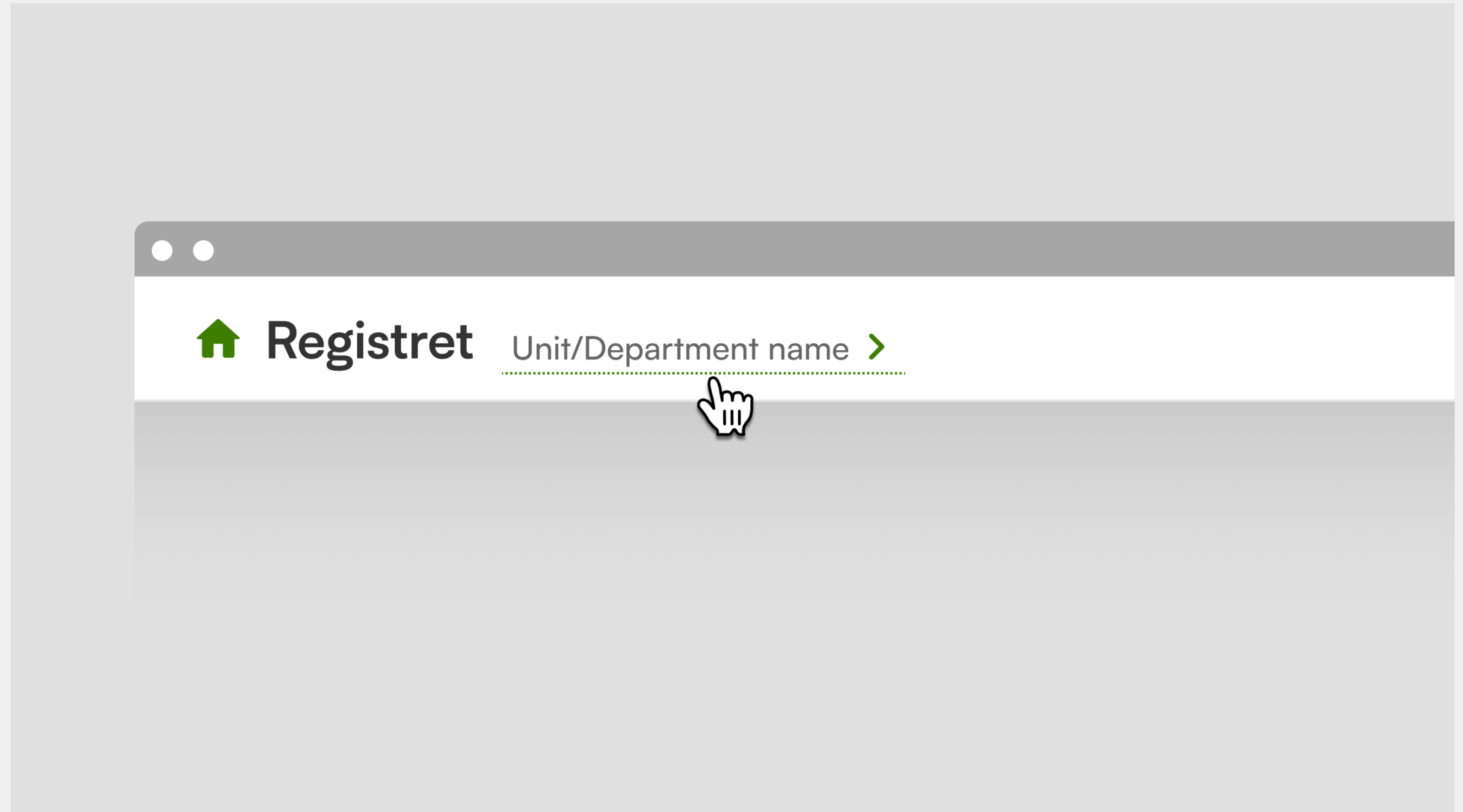
A separate settings page that holds everything that relates to the user that is signed in. Here you can **change unit** or **change language** (for registries with several languages).



# Shortcut in the header to change unit

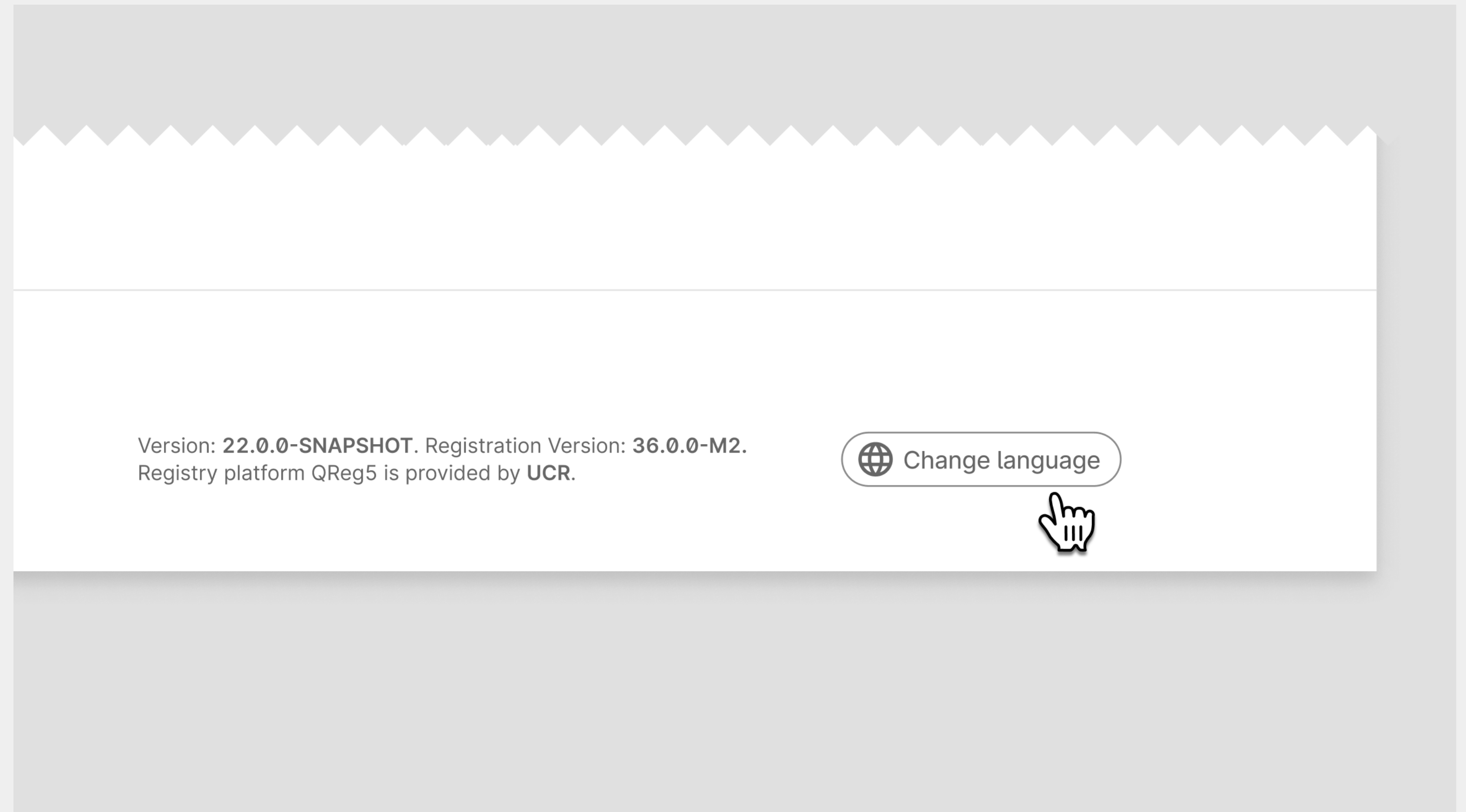
The header now has a shortcut to the **settings page** where the user can change unit.

If you have more than one unit available, they can go directly to the settings page by clicking on the unit/department name.



# Shortcut in the footer to change language

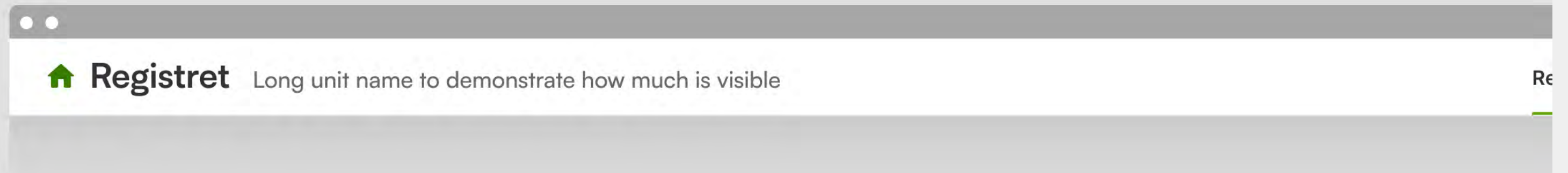
Change language is now also in the **footer**. This applies for all registries with more than one language available.



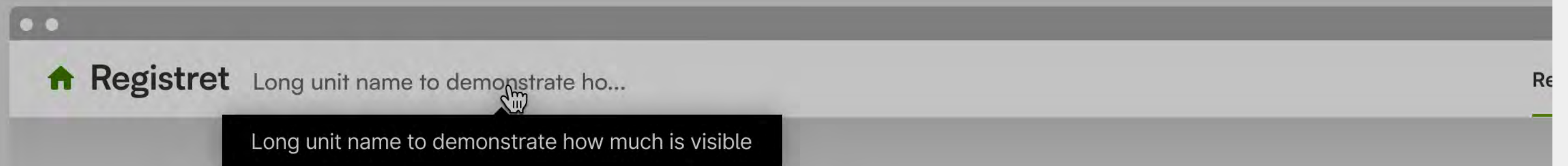
# Show more of long unit names

Longer names are no longer truncated as early. Now instead, as much of the name as possible is shown depending on the width of the browser window.

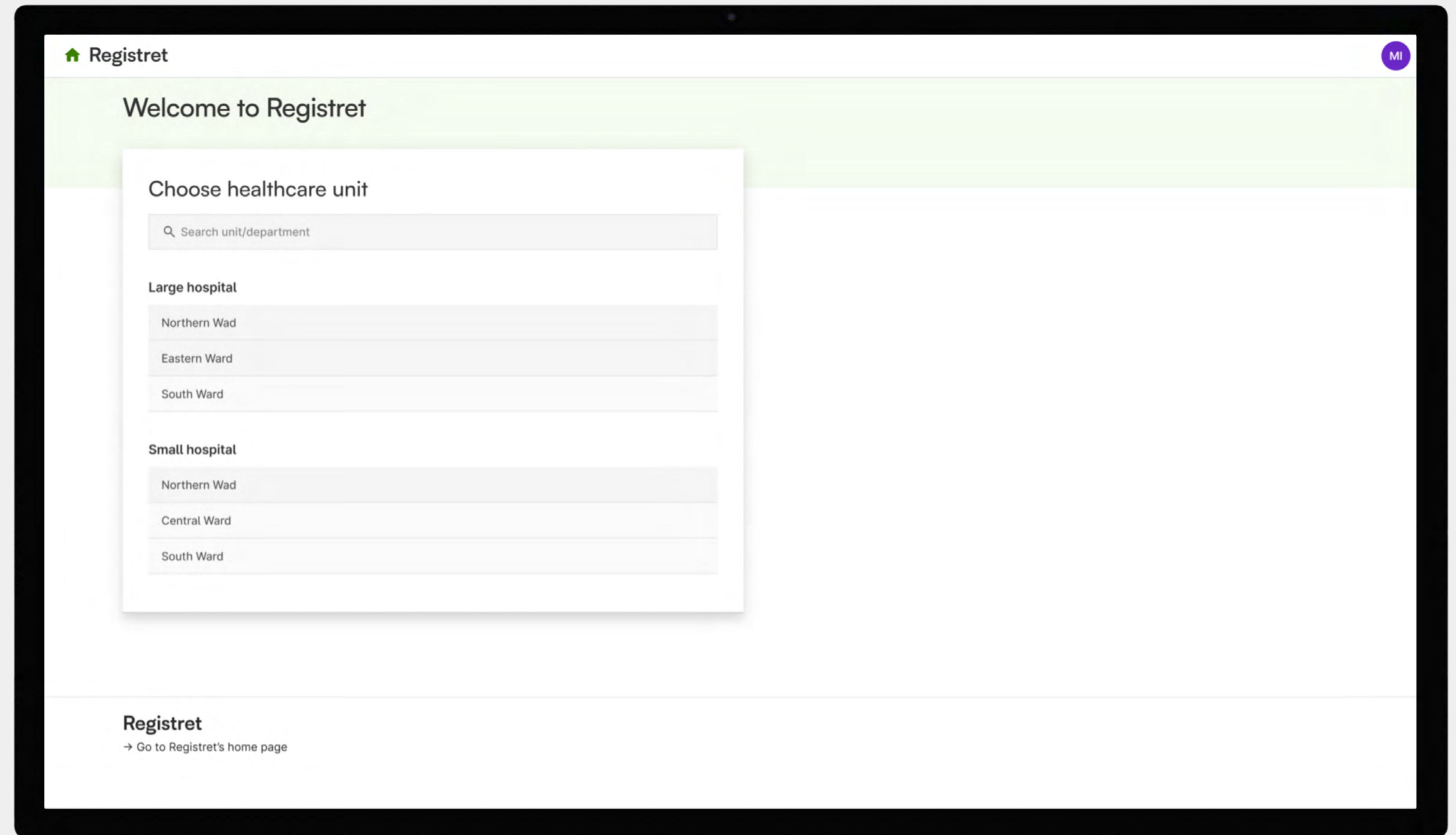

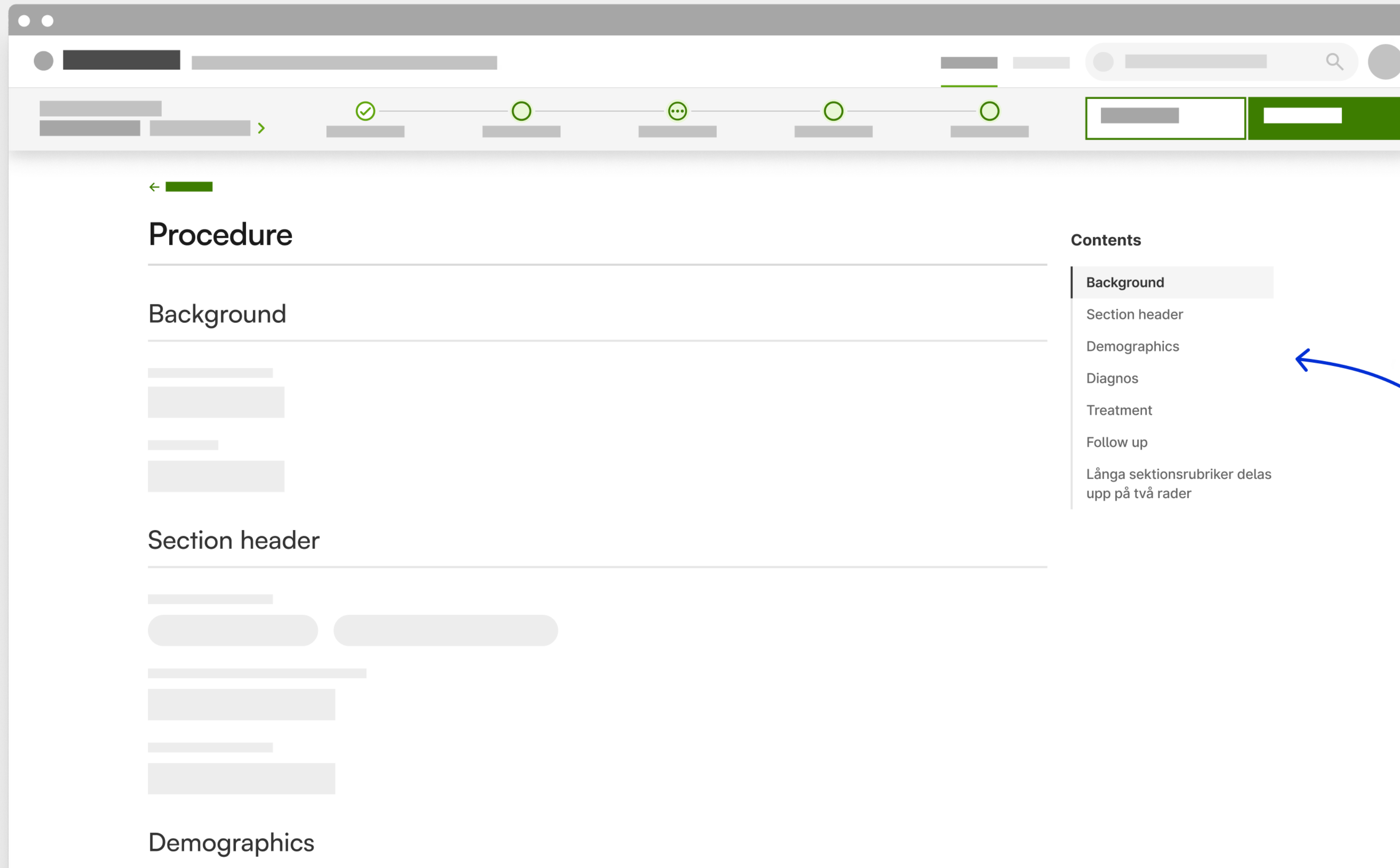


# Updated welcome page

# Navigation inside a registration

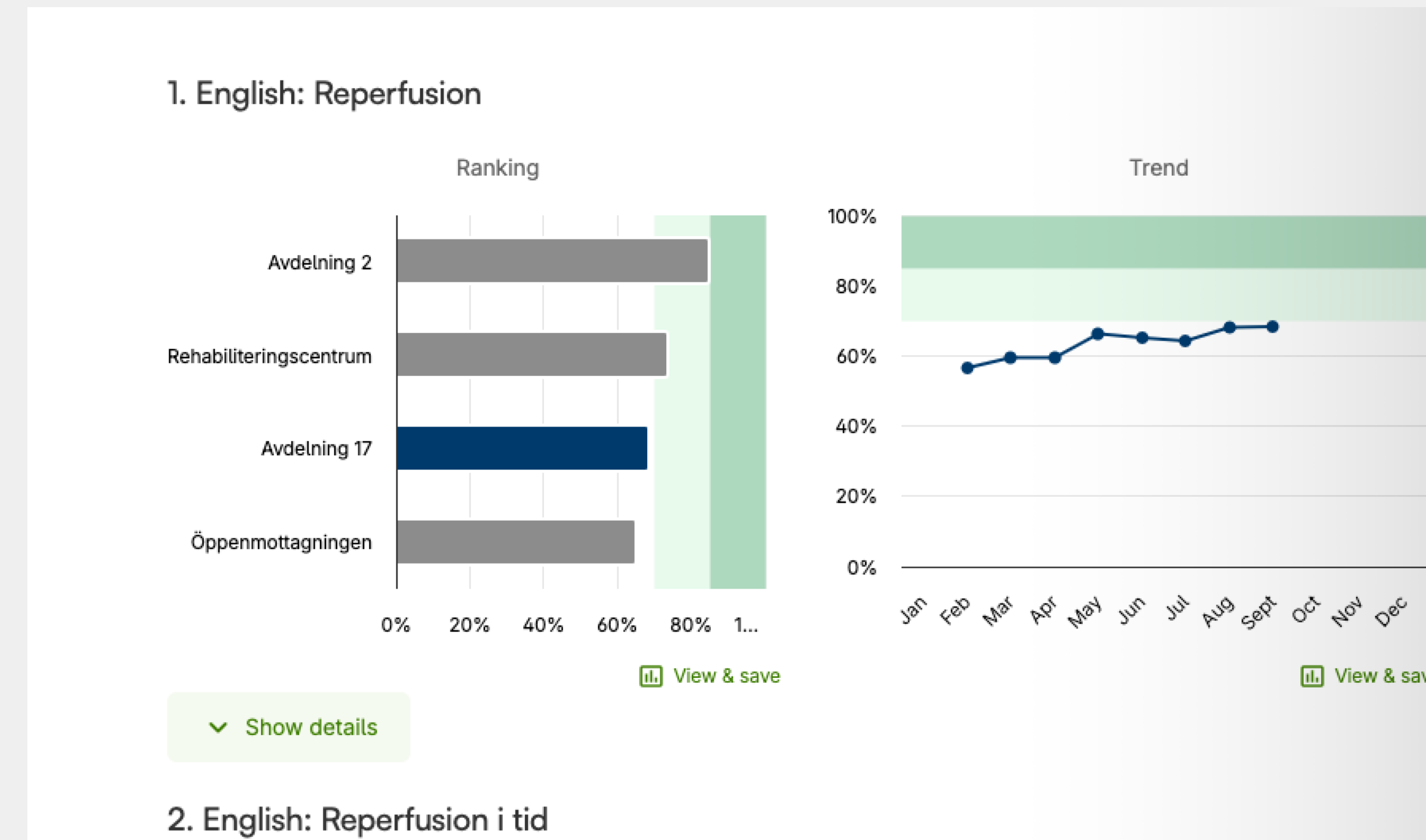
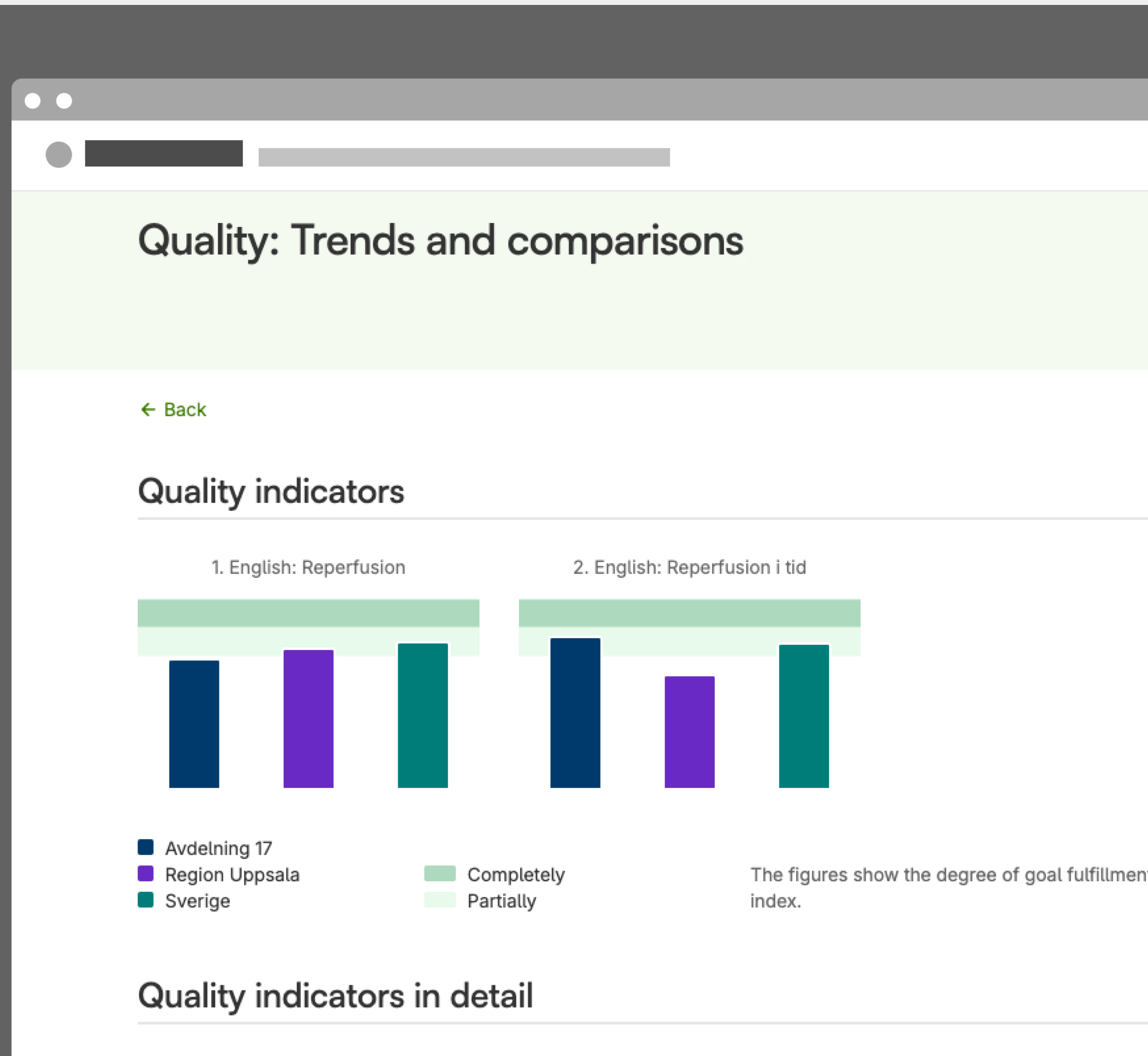


**Navigating inside a registration.**

# New colour palette for reports

All charts and graphs now have an updated colour palette. The new colours have been developed so that as many people as possible can read and take in the information in the graphs – even if you have some kind of colour blindness or visual impairment. This change has been made in order to comply to the current legislation on accessibility.

The target areas have also been adjusted. The shades for if a target is partially or completely fulfilled have been changed to a lighter and darker green colour.

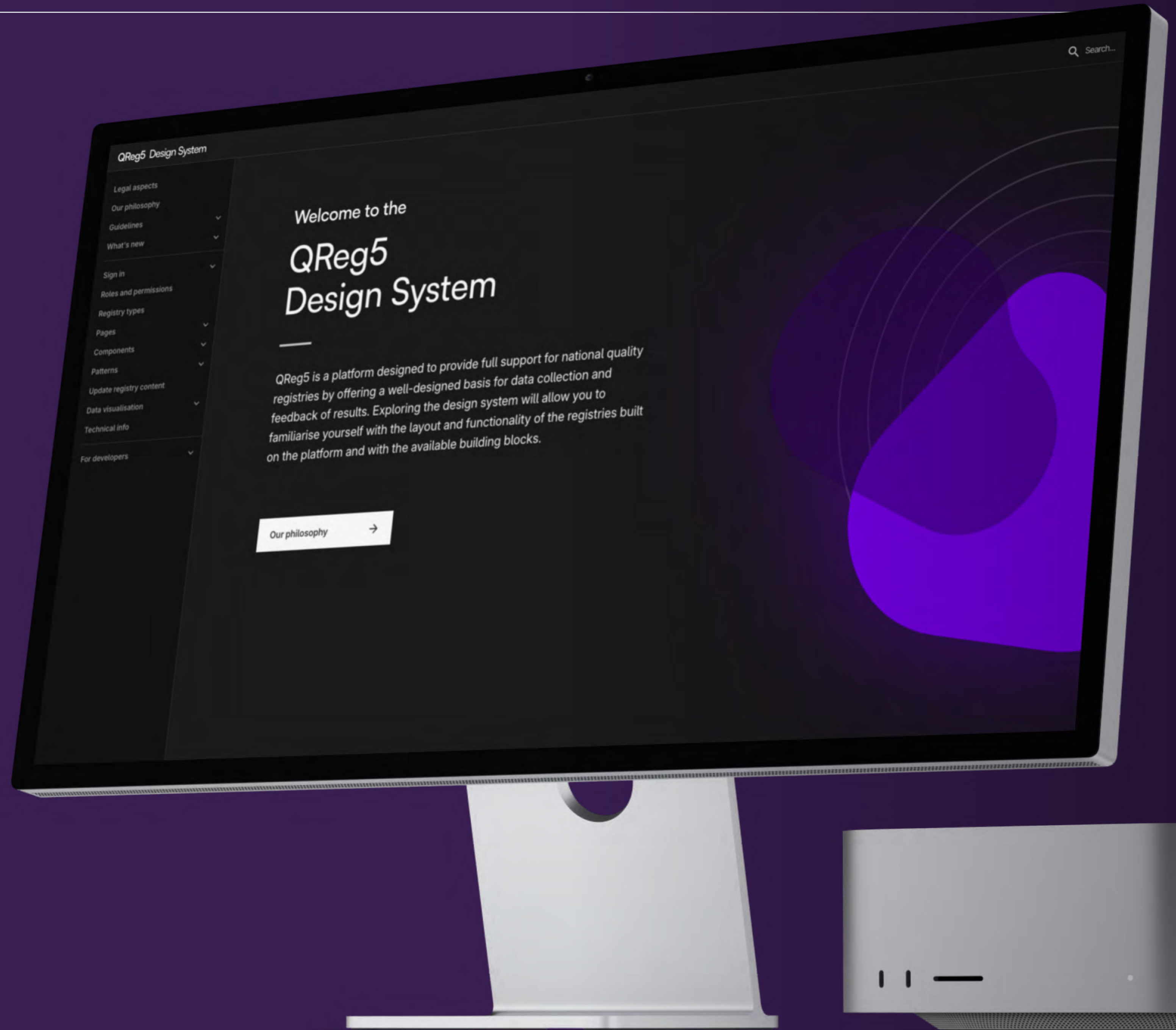
